How to Install and Program a MOTOTRBO IMPRES Vibra Alert Belt Clip and Vibrate Battery

This Vibra Alert Belt Clip and Vibrate Battery are available for the XPR3000/e and XPR7000/e Radio Series.

As always, please refer to the Radio Model User Guide for Vibration Style and Configuration. Typically, the Vibra Alert function will work with QCII and MDC signaling.

When installing the Vibra Alert Belt Clip the radio must be turned off.

First, connect the Vibra Alert Belt Clip to the battery and then both the Vibra Alert Belt Clip and Vibrate Battery to the radio.

CAUTION: When installing the Vibra Alert Belt Clip be careful not to break the pins on the Vibra Alert Belt Clip.

To enable this feature, the user should access the Radio Menu and under the field Alert Tones, set to Vibrate. Enjoy!
